Keep Pests Out

Information for Poultry and Egg Producers

Pests such as wild birds, rodents, and insects can carry avian influenza (AI) onto a housing site. Biosecurity measures can help keep pests out and ensure the health of the birds on a site.

Clean

Keep the site clean to reduce attraction of wild birds, rodents, and insects

- * Remove trash
- Clean up feed spills
- Dispose of dead birds and waste eggs

Exclude

Prevent wild birds, rodents, and insects from entering your facilities

- Seal or screen doors, windows, and vents
- ❖ Plug holes larger than ¼ inch and seal foundation cracks
- ❖ Line building perimeters with gravel
- ❖ Mow grass/brush around buildings

Control

Implement control programs to reduce wild bird, rodent, and insect populations

- * Rodents: use rodenticides (poison baits) and traps
- ❖ Insects: utilize chemical (insecticide) or biological control methods
- ❖ Adhere to state and local regulations for controlling wild birds, rodents, and insects
