

Biosecure Entry Procedure



What is a Biosecure Entry Procedure?

- A biosecure way to enter the PBA or cross the LOS
- Occurs at the PBA Access Point AND the LOS Access Point (but may be different at each)

Why is it Important?

- Following specific biosecurity steps decreases the risk of bringing disease onto the poultry site

How is it Performed?

- Steps may vary depending on your job duties
- Includes Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) needs and Cleaning and Disinfection (C&D) protocols
- Specific requirements can be found in the site's biosecurity plan, especially the section specific to your job duty, or the sections on 'Personnel' or 'Equipment and Vehicles'

Biosecure Exit Procedure

- Decreases the risk of disease leaving the poultry site
- Usually the reverse of the Biosecure Entry Procedure
- Includes steps to remove PPE and reduce contamination on clothing and exposed skin before leaving the site
